### 5. Important Notes

1. There are limited spaces available at the Cromwell College Apartments and International Students compete against New Zealand students for these places. It is advisable to lodge applications for these places as early as possible. The Apartments close during school holidays. International Students who live at the Apartments will move into a 'school arranged' home-stay situation during the holiday period.
2. The Apartments expense covers accommodation and food allowance for living at the Apartments. It is important to note that the Cromwell College Apartments is a "Learn To Flat" situation. Students are responsible for their own cooking, menu planning, cleaning etc. Live in adult managers provide expert assistance and supervision with this programme.
3. All the students who live in The Apartments must take part in either the Golf Academy or The Outdoor Pursuits Programme. A separate Apartment agreement must be signed.
4. Golf Academy and Outdoor Pursuits expenses cover all costs related to these programmes including instruction/coaching fees, transport, gear etc. Students in the Outdoors Pursuits

Programme are provided with a basic set of outdoor gear which remains their own property. It includes a rain coat, cooking set, head mounted torch, sleeping mat, aquatic shoes and climbing harness.

5. All educationally related expenses are included in the tuition fees such as class field trips, course materials and workbooks, IELTS classes etc. It does not cover entry fees to NCEA or Correspondence School.
6. The Bond is a fund of money held by Cromwell College on the student's behalf. It can be used to for uniforms, national qualifications, entry costs or personal expenses at the discretion of the Director of International Students. Any unused bond money will be refunded to the student at the end of their time at Cromwell College.
7. The Outdoor Education Programme fee is for expenses for the specialised programmes that take place on Thursday. A student can choose to participate in Outdoor Education which includes windsurfing, kayaking, mountain biking and tramping in Terms 1, 2 and 4 while Term 3 is Skiing/Snowboarding. The fees cover equipment hire, instruction, transport, and lift pass. The fee is non refundable once the course has begun.
8. Cromwell College has a refund policy for International Students. Please refer to the International Students Handbook for more details.
9. At the end of the year students may need to stay longer in order to complete national qualifications exams. Alternatively students who have finished all their work may depart earlier. The school will refund or charge additional accommodation costs as appropriate to the situation.

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
