\* Please note that the basic fee structure will remain the same for the entire 2012 year. It is possible that there may be a small increase in accommodation fees to cover an increase in the cost of living should this occur.

## 5. Important Notes

1. There are limited spaces available at the Cromwell College Apartments and International Students compete against New Zealand students for these places. It is advisable to lodge applications for these places as early as possible. The Apartments close during school holidays. International Students who live at the Apartments will move into a 'school arranged' home-stay situation during the holiday period.
2. If Apartments students do not need a home stay during term holidays because they go on go on a supervised tour for example, their homestay fee is refunded to them.
3. This invoice assumes that the student leaves immediately at the end of their final term. If s/he stays longer and requires homestay accommodation there will be an additional charge of \$30 per day or \$220 per week.
4. The Apartments expense covers accommodation and food allowance for living at the Apartments. It is important to note that the Cromwell College Apartments is a "Learn to Flat" situation. Students are responsible for their own cooking, menu planning, cleaning etc. Live in adult managers provide expert assistance and supervision with this programme.
5. All the students who live in The Apartments must take part in The Outdoor Pursuits Programme. A separate Apartment agreement must be signed.
6. The Outdoor Education Programme fee covers expenses related to the specialised programmes that take place on Thursday. A student can choose to participate in Outdoor Education which includes windsurfing, kayaking, mountain biking and tramping in Terms 1, 2 and 4. Term 3 is Skiing/Snowboarding. The fees cover equipment hire, instruction, transport, and lift pass. The fee is non refundable once the course has begun. If a student is in the Outdoor Pursuits Academy as well as the Outdoor Education Programme, the Term 3 bill for Outdoor Education is reduced by \$300.
7. All educationally related expenses are included in the tuition fees such as class field trips, course materials and workbooks, IELTS classes. It does not cover option fees for specialist subjects such as Outdoor Education, Photography and Food or Materials Technology. It does not cover entry fees to NCEA or Correspondence School.
8. The Bond is a fund of money held by Cromwell College on the student's behalf. It can be used for medical expenses, prescriptions from the pharmacy, school stationery and field trips. Any unused bond money will be refunded to the student at the end of their time at Cromwell College.
9. At the end of the year students may need to stay longer in order to complete national qualifications exams. Alternatively students who have finished all their work may depart earlier. The school will refund or charge additional accommodation costs as appropriate to the situation.

10. If a student remains in New Zealand over the summer break a fee will be charged to cover the costs of administration and pastoral care associated with this.
11. Cromwell College has a refund policy for International Students. Please refer to the International Students Handbook for more details.
